



Call for Proposals 2010

This year, TRaid is committing £360,000 to international development projects.

Project Funding Criteria

TRAID will prioritise funding applications for:

- Projects that combat the negative impacts of the textile industry on people and the environment
- Projects that improve rights, health and incomes - especially of those working in the chain of textile supply and production, including children and home workers
- Projects which enable people to transform and improve their environment sustainably to bring about improvements to their lives and livelihoods

Project approach

Projects must be needs-based and participatory. Projects should involve the active participation of stakeholders in design, implementation, monitoring and evaluation processes. Projects must be finite or financially self-sustaining in 4 years or less. Projects should be innovative and creative, and must be environmentally-sensitive & sustainable, and technically, environmentally and culturally appropriate. Where appropriate, projects should address the capacity of stakeholders to advocate for their own rights. Projects should not duplicate or replace existing programmes in the project area.

Amount of TRaid funding

TRAID will consider application for any amount of funding up to the total budget available.

Full cost recovery

TRAID recognises that in addition to the costs directly associated with a project, such as staff and equipment, projects will also draw on the rest of an organisation. The full cost of any project should therefore be applied for.

How to apply

We are operating a 2 stage Concept Note/Application Form process.

Interested organisations are invited to submit a Concept Note, no longer than one page of A4, which must be received at TRAIID Head Office by close of business on 1st June 2010. Please do not send more than one page of A4 as supplementary pages will be discarded. Please remember to include your name and contact details.

The Concept Note should include details of the project objective, location, beneficiaries, duration and approximate amount requested, and how the project relates to TRAIID's funding criteria.

The receipt of Concept Notes will be acknowledged via email by close of business on 1st June 2010.

Organisations invited to submit a full proposal will be notified and sent a project application pack by close of business on 3rd June 2010.

The deadline for submission of full project proposals will be close of business on 13th July 2010.

Final funding decisions will be made by 2nd September 2010.
